APA Style Reference Examples

All references and in-text citations must follow the APA 7th edition referencing style. Authors are responsible for ensuring that all sources cited in the manuscript are included in the reference list and that all references listed are cited in the text.

Authors should pay particular attention to the following:

Journal articles should include author name(s), publication year, article title, journal title, volume, issue, page range or article number, and DOI where available.

Books should include author name(s), publication year, book title, edition information where applicable, and publisher.

Chapters in edited books should include chapter author name(s), publication year, chapter title, editor name(s), book title, page range, publisher, and DOI where available.

Online sources should include author or organization name, publication date or last update date where available, title of the page or document, website name where applicable, and URL.

DOIs should be provided as active links whenever available.
